**objectives:** *As small group members and guests, we will:*

1. Recognize God's universal call to His church.
2. Recognize how we fit into this plan and call.
3. Recognize what the Father may be doing in our lives right now to fulfill this call.

**study/prayer time:** *Please feel free to adjust this study to fit your group's needs and to the direction of the Holy Spirit. It is not necessary to use all of the questions.*

1. Pray for your friends who need Jesus.
2. Ask some volunteers to read Ephesians 3:6-12, Matthew 28:18-20 and John 5:19. What stands out to you in these passages?
3. Ephesians was written nearly 2,000 years ago to a completely different audience. How does this passage speak to the church today?

4. In these passages we see that God is asking us to be a part of His plan and to partner with Him. What are some things in your life right now that you are doing or that God may be asking you to do to step into this call?
5. In the passage from Matthew Jesus instructs us as his believers to make disciples of the world. Are you currently in a discipleship relationship with anyone? If so, what has this experience been like?
6. What are some of the ways that you may have personally seen and experienced the church carrying out God's call?
7. In the passage in Ephesians, we see God's mysterious plan revealed, as well as how it was carried out (through Christ). In what ways does seeing God's plan encourage you personally?
8. Take a moment to re-read John 5:19. How is this passage speaking to your life right now? Is there anything going on that you may be trying to do on your own and could use God's help?
9. After a time of worship break into groups of 2 or 3 and pray for one another. Consider asking God to reveal to you how you personally fit into His plan and call on the church.
